This last time I took it to a new service place, they suggested I looked into changing the Manual Transmission Fluid. Check your brake fluid level on a bi-weekly basis, using the markings on the reservoir. Add fluid as necessary, referring to your F-150's owner's manual for type. Change your Brake fluid every 50,000 to 80,000 kilometers Changing your brake fluid requires a socket set, screwdrivers, rubber tubing, a drain bucket, and an assistant to help out. I've seen several recommendations here to change automatic transmission fluid as often as 30K, no matter what the manufacturer recommends. My Ford Fusion recommends changing at 30K for special service conditions but 150K for normal use, and there's no way my driving, which includes a daily 15 mile (each way) commute on a flat, uncrowded highway, could be considered severe service. How often are you supposed to get your gear oil changed out for your manual transmission? I was talking to a mechanic today who said in a manual Ford you never need it changed unless you do tranny work, and one I talked to a few weeks ago said get it changed at 30k. So I'm at about 31k now, and... what do I do?
