

Download Pentecost Games For Kids

Many Christians celebrate Pentecost, the birthday of the church and the coming of the Holy Spirit. The holiday falls 50 days after Easter Sunday. So this lesson may be particularly appropriate at that time, but could also be used any time in exploration of the Bible text found in Acts 2. Pentecost - Game Idea – "Carrying the Light & Passing it On" Activity: Playing this simple game will help the kids remember that the point of the story is to find the flame and pass it on! How To Play: One (or more people) are 'firestarters' and carry the flame. Players go around the room and take turns shaking hands. Pentecost Activities for Children.
