Middle-earth is a large continent, a mass of land that occupies the central regions of Arda. It lays between two continents; Aman, the uttermost West from which it is separated by the ocean Belegaer, and the Land of the Sun, at the uttermost East which the East Sea separates. The Westlands are the most well-known regions of the continent, and the only which have been mapped in great detail. In J. R. R. Tolkien's legendarium, Elves are one of the races that inhabit a fictional Earth, often called Middle-earth, and set in the remote past. They appear in *The Hobbit* and in *The Lord of the Rings*, but their complex history is described more fully in *The Silmarillion*. Tolkien had been writing about Elves long before he published *The Hobbit*. The following is a list of characters from J. R. R. Tolkien's Middle-earth legendarium.
