The IEP outlines special education programming with accommodations and/or modifications of curriculum. For students who meet the eligibility criteria to take the New York State Alternate Assessment (NYSAA) and for preschool students with disabilities, the IEP must include a description of the short-term instructional objectives and/or benchmarks that are the measurable intermediate steps between the student's present levels of performance and the measurable annual goals.
