Sentence processing takes place whenever a reader or listener processes a language utterance, either in isolation or in the context of a conversation or a text.. Many studies of the human language comprehension process have focused on reading of single utterances (sentences) without context. Language processing refers to the way humans use words to communicate ideas and feelings, and how such communications are processed and understood. Language processing is considered to be a uniquely human ability that is not produced with the same grammatical understanding or systematicity in even human's closest primate relatives. The TAPS-4 assesses skills across three intersecting areas: phonological processing, auditory memory and listening comprehension.
