Aucott, MD, a renowned expert in clinical research on the diagnosis and epidemiology of Lyme disease, was the recipient of the Lauren F. Brooks Hope Award at the Global Lyme Alliance "Time for Lyme" Gala on April 11, 2015. The LD spirochete, *Borrelia burgdorferi*, infects other species of ticks but is known to be transmitted to humans and other animals only by the deer tick (also known as the black-legged tick) and the related Western black-legged tick. Studies have shown that an infected tick normally cannot begin transmitting the spirochete until it has been attached to its host about 36-48 hours; the best line ...
