Bonsai (Japanese: 盆栽, lit. 'tray planting', pronunciation (help · info)) is the Japanese pronunciation of the Sino-Japanese word "盆景". It is an Asian art form using cultivation techniques to produce small trees in containers that mimic the shape and scale of full size trees. Although "tree" is a term of common parlance, there is no universally recognised precise definition of what a tree is, either botanically or in common language. In its broadest sense, a tree is any plant with the general form of an elongated stem, or trunk, which supports the photosynthetic leaves or branches at some distance above the ground.
